Parents' Evening:

We plan to host a Parents' Evening for our parents who wish to meet with their child's subject/class teachers and discuss their child's performance for this year. This gives both the parent and the teacher a chance to interact and provide valuable information that otherwise may not be made available. The Parents' Evening is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, 2 May 2023. Further details for the Parents' Evening will be made available in due course.

Uniform

Please support our school by ensuring that our children are dressed in their correct school uniform. Uniformity in school dress enhances the tone of a school and fosters among the scholars a feeling of "belonging together", a sense of loyalty and pride in what they regard as their own. We request parents to assist us by ensuring that children are equipped with the correct uniform from the beginning of the term and that they comply with the dress regulations before they leave home in the mornings. Learners and parents are also requested to note that the school rules apply anywhere a learner is identifiable as a member of the Bryneven school community. It is obviously particularly important that the uniform be worn properly in public places such as on buses, in shopping centres and on the way to and from school. Children must wear the correct sports kit when practising their sport.

Boys hair should be cut to the appropriate length and not touch their ears or collar. Learners 'hair should not cover their eyes. Fashionable designs cut in the side of the boy's hair and highlights are also not allowed. Girls should not have different coloured hair extensions. The wearing of fashionably coloured hair accessories is also not allowed. Girls' hair should be tied neatly with the appropriate school coloured band. It is a requirement that as part of their uniform, boys wear the proper Bryneven school socks. Parents can make use of either of the two official suppliers of Bryneven uniforms. (Please refer to the D6 Communicator.) Thank you for your co-operation in this important matter.

School Photographs will be taken next Tuesday, 18 April. Please ensure that your child is dressed in the correct summer uniform.

Mid-year Exams

The Exam week will be taking place from 31 May to 09 June. The reference notes and Exam timetable will be distributed in due course.

Extramurals

- Term 2 Extramurals: The Extramural Programme will be distributed later this week. We have a number of additional external coaches who assist us and as a result we have to accommodate the times when they will be available to help at school. Coaches will notify their age groups about additional practice sessions where required. The focus during the next couple of days will be training for the teams participating in the upcoming match against Bryanston Primary.
- Notification of matches: Just a reminder that players will be provided with a note indicating the specific details and requirements about the matches.
- Please stay off the sports fields before school: Our Sports Department will be preparing our fields for the Bryneven Tournament very soon. We request that children keep off the sports fields before school starts. The sprinkler system switches on early in the morning and we are concerned that the wet turf could easily be damaged while the field is still wet.
- Sports Achievements for the newsletter and assembly: Parents are cordially requested to direct their notifications about sporting achievements to school for the attention of Mr P Naicker

(Extramural Co-ordinator.) Often, we are given the names of only a few children in a particular sporting code (who have achieved selection, etc) when in fact there are more Bryneven children involved. Once specific details are confirmed, Mr Naicker will provide the information for the assembly, newsletter, etc.



Some arrangements to take note for Soccer this term: With many of children playing Club football, we thought it important to provide all our families with the following information. It is expected that school activities will take priority:

Wednesdays - Under 9 to Open Soccer League matches: Please take note that our teams will once again be participating in the Johannesburg Schools Football League. Both the Under 9 and Under 10 age group matches take the form of 7-a-side matches with the Under 11 to Open teams playing the normal 11-a-side matches. Most league matches take place on Wednesdays.

Thursdays - Under 8 League matches: The Under 8 (7-a-side games) matches will take place on Thursdays.


Johannesburg Schools Knock-out Cup Matches: All the Boys' First teams from the Under 9 to Under 13 age groups will be participating in this competition. The Girls' teams participating in this competition will consist of the Under 9, Under 11 and Under 14 teams. Knock-out Cup matches will be played using the normal format, i.e. 11-a-side. These matches will be played on days to suit both schools. Players will be informed closer to K/O Cup match days.
