

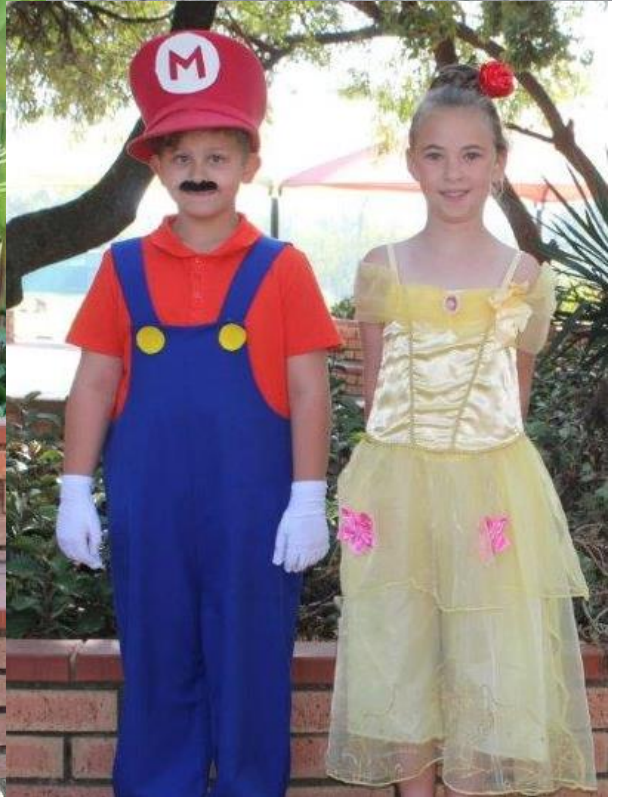
World Book Day
