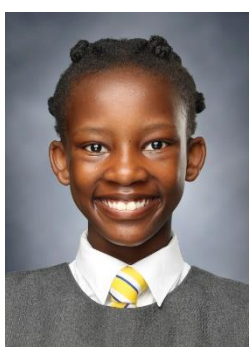

On Thursday, 31 August several of our parents came out to play while their children were away. The fundraising team would like to thank all the parents for their support. It was an awesome night.



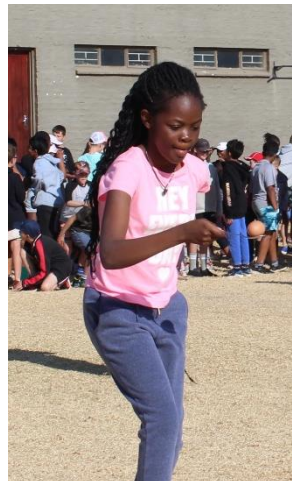
Grade 4-7 Tours
