Bryneven Fun Netball and Soccer Festival and Bring and Braai.

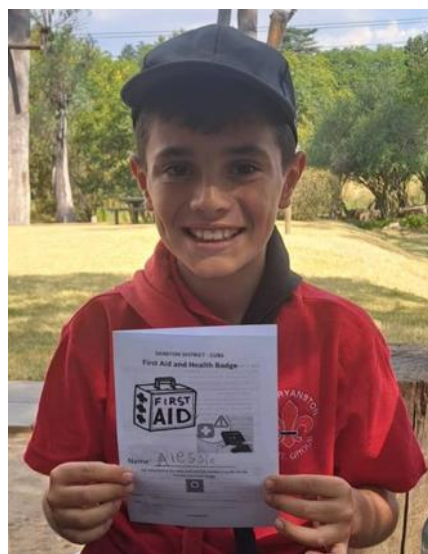
We held our Fun Netball and Soccer festival on Friday, 15 March. We had close to 300 learners participating. Thank you to all our staff, learners and parents for joining us.
