Term 2 report cards will only be available on the Ed-Admin Parent Portal on Friday, 14 June 2024 from 11h00.

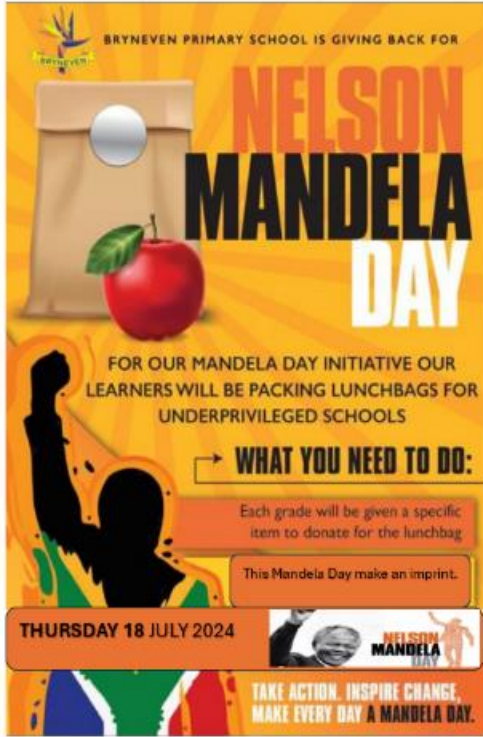

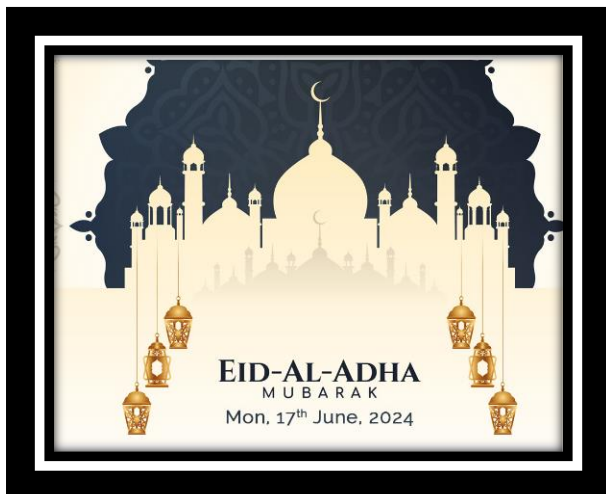
